Entry Instructions and Rules

1. **Entry Deadline:** The 2012 Entry Form, along with other requested entry materials, must be received no later than **July 20, 2012**, or delivered at the July meeting of TVQG. The Quilt Show Committee reserves the right to refuse any entry it deems inappropriate or which fails to meet entry requirements. Show Committee may delete an entry for lack of show space.

2. Entries will not be accepted until the entry form is **completely filled out with the "Hold Harmless Agreement" signed by the entrant.** Each entry shall consist of:

- Completed Entry Form
- Fees (if applicable)
- One CLEAR color photo of the entry, labeled with the entrant's name and quilt title. All photos will become the property of TVQG and will not be returned. Photos can be taken at Guild meetings at a cost of \$1.00 per photo.

3. Each TVQG Member may enter quilts in Judged and/or Non-Judged Categories plus Challenge, Silent Auction, and Special Exhibits. **Members are NOT limited in the number of quilts they may enter in all categories.** Non-members are limited to entries in the Judged Show **only**. Entry fees per quilt in the Judged Show are \$7 for members and \$25 for nonmembers. There are no fees for members' entries in the non-judged categories.

4. A Category must be clearly indicated on the Entry Form. If unsure of proper category, make your best guess then provide additional information about the entry and reason for your uncertainty on a separate piece of paper. We will determine final placement.

5. Entries shown in the 2011, 2010 and 2009 Quilt Shows are not eligible to be shown in 2012. Entries in [TVQG Quilt Shows](#) prior to 2009, are eligible to be shown again. [Judged entries can only be entered by the owner of the entry.](#)

6. All entries in judged categories must be quilted by hand or machine or any combination thereof. No tied quilts or bar tacked quilts will be allowed in the judged categories. Garments must have recognizable amount of patchwork, appliqué and/or mixed techniques and some recognizable quilting.

7. Entries do not have to be finished when photographed. However, we strongly discourage the withdrawal of entries from the show. If you cannot be absolutely certain that your entry will be complete when entries are to be delivered, please do not enter it!

8. All categories are both judged and non-judged with the exception of categories 16, 18 and 19. All entries in categories 16 and 19 are judged with no judging fee. Category 18 is non-judged.

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Entry Categories

Please read all the categories carefully and decide which one **best** fits your quilt. If you are unsure, make your best guess and attach an explanation for why you picked the category that you did. **The Quilt Show Committee reserves the right to move a quilt to a different category, split or combine categories depending on entries received.**

01 – Large Pieced Hand Quilted

Any quilt which is larger than 68" on **any** side and *primarily* patchwork; hand quilted

02 – Large Appliqué Hand Quilted

Any quilt which is larger than 68" on **any** side and *primarily* appliqué; hand quilted

03 – Large Pieced Machine Quilted

Any quilt which is larger than 68" on **any** side and *primarily* patchwork; machine quilted

04 – Large Appliqué Machine Quilted

Any quilt which is larger than 68" on **any** side and *primarily* appliqué; machine quilted

05 – Small Pieced Hand Quilted

Any quilt which is smaller than 68" on **all** sides and *primarily* patchwork; hand quilted

06 – Small Appliqué Hand Quilted

Any quilt which is smaller than 68" on **all** sides and *primarily* appliqué; hand quilted

07 – Small Pieced Machine Quilted

Any quilt which is smaller than 68" on **all** sides and *primarily* patchwork; machine quilted

08 – Small Appliqué Machine Quilted

Any quilt which is smaller than 68" on **all** sides and *primarily* appliqué; machine quilted

09 – One Person/Machine Quilted

Any size quilt pieced, appliqué and/or using other techniques and machine quilted. Quilt should be entirely made by one person.

10 – Art Quilt

Original design by maker/entrant;

Any technique or combination of techniques or materials used in a non-traditional way. Entry has been made by one person and only one person.

11 – Miniature Quilts

Any quilt which has no side measuring more than 24". Any technique may be used. If interior blocks are part of the Design, these blocks must measure 4" or less.

12 – Mixed Techniques

Any quilt that is a combination of equal parts of pieced and appliqué, hand or machine quilted.

13 – Other Techniques

Wholecloth, Embroidered, Cathedral Window, Yo-Yo, Crazy Quilts, or any other quilt that doesn't fit into the pieced, appliqué or art quilt categories. May be hand or machine quilted or combination of both.

14 – Block of the Month/Kit Quilts

Any size quilt made from a Block of the Month or Quilt Kit. May be hand or machine quilted or a combination of both.

15 – Garment

Must include a recognizable amount of patchwork, appliqué and quilting.

16 – Guild Challenge – **Guild Members Only**

Quilt must be no larger than 36" on any side and must depict a memory. You must also include a paragraph telling about your memory (50 words or less). See rules on page 2.

17 – Group/Friendship

Made by a group of three or more.

18 – Young Quilters (17 and under)

Any quilt made by a quilter aged 17 or under. These quilts may utilize any piecing, appliqué or quilting method, may be an individual or group effort, and can be any size. **This category will not be judged.**

19 – Apron Challenge – **Guild Members Only**

Must be new construction and fit into one of the defined categories. See rules on page 2.

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Preparation for the Show

1. Each entry must have a fabric identification label stitched to the lower back of the quilt. **No PINS!** The label must include your name and the title of the quilt/garment. Labels for garments and other entries should be stitched to the inside of the piece(s).

2. Every quilt must have a 4" sleeve stitched to the top of the back of the quilt on the horizontal width. Miniatures may use smaller rod pockets of only 2" in diameter. **Quilts longer than 86" must have a sleeve attached no more than 86" from the bottom edge of the quilt.**

3. Each quilt entry must be submitted in a fabric bag with the entrant's name and title of entry on the bag. Only **ONE ENTRY PER BAG**. Garment entries may be submitted in a garment bag with same information.

4. Insuring quilts is the responsibility of the entrant. Check your homeowner's insurance policy for coverage.

5. All entries **MUST** remain on display for the duration of the show.

Rules for the Small Quilt Silent Auction

1. **Maximum size for a small quilt is 24" on a side if you want your quilt(s) to be judged.**

2. Any technique, style or theme is acceptable as well as any embellishments you wish to add.

3. Attach a label to the lower right corner of the **BACK** side of the quilt. Include your name, year made, title of quilt (if there is one), and any other pertinent information you wish to add. Information should be stitched or written with a pigma permanent pen.

4. A sleeve is **not** required but would be appreciated - many buyers have expressed a desire for one.

Delivery/Pickup

1. Deliver entries in person September 27, 2012 between 8 & 9 a.m. to the Roundup Inn Receiving Area, Amon Carter Exhibit Hall, Will Rogers Memorial Complex. Pick up entries between 5:00 & 6:00 p.m. on Sunday, September 30, 2012.

2. Shipment of entries must be done so they arrive between September 19, and September 26, 2012. Ship entries to Quilter's Dream, 6409 Colleyville Blvd., Colleyville, TX 76034-6224. Return of shipped entries will be by UPS Ground Service shipped no later than Wednesday, October 3, 2011. Please include a return address label and a check payable to TVQG for shipping charges of \$35 per entry (includes shipping insurance.) **Quilter's Dream is ONLY accepting quilts MAILED to that location. If you are not mailing your quilt, you must deliver your quilt to the Quilt Show for check-in on Thursday, September 27th. Quilter's Dream will NOT accept quilts in person, only by mail.**

Rules for Guild Challenge Quilts

1. **Your quilt should depict a memory you have from any time.**
2. **No side can be larger than 36".**
3. **You must include a paragraph telling about your memory (50 words or less).**
4. **Quilt will be judged on how well it depicts the stated memory.**

Rules for Guild Apron Challenge

1. **Your apron must be new construction**
2. **The aprons will be judged according to the following categories:**
 - **Best Repurposed Linens**
 - **Best Original Design**
 - **Best Hip / Retro**
 - **Most Like Grandma's**
 - **Most Functional**

Quilt Appraisals

Appraisals will be done by an AQS Certified Appraiser. Appraisals are needed to establish the value of quilted items for insurance, fair market value of quilted items, donation & estate settlement purposes.

If you wish to have a written appraisal of your quilt, please note it on your entry form.

Appointments for appraisals on quilts **not entered** in the show can be made for Friday, September 28, 2012, during show hours by calling: Judy Linn at 817 994-3211.

Cost per written appraisal is \$40.00 payable to TVQG.
